Subject: Planning Council Resignation

Supervisor Sandy,

Thank you for the opportunity to be part of the Local Child Care Planning Council (LPC) for the past seven years. It is with mixed emotions that I resign effective September 1, 2023. There is still much work to be done.

These past few years have been difficult for families and child care providers. The LPC has made much progress and has been challenged to find its way in the child care advocacy landscape. In part I believe this is due to its fiscal relationship with the

Yolo County Office of Education (YCOE). YCOE is the fiscal agent for the LPC. In an annual grant of \$51,117, only about 37% goes to fund council activities and program services, while 62% of the LPC's budget goes to YCOE for support of one kind or another. Fifteen percent of the allocation goes to "non-direct" and "in-direct" costs that support the administrative functions of YCOE and seem disproportionate to the actual costs of supporting the LPC. This in no way is a criticism of the front-line staff coordinating and supporting the functions of the LPC. They are committed, hard-working and diligent. It may, however, be time to find another fiscal "home" for the LPC that is better aligned with its focus on all child care providers, families, and children and can provide support "in-kind" or at a much reduced rate. A clearer identification through the creation of LPC advocacy policy which is currently underway, will clarify the responsibilities and perspectives of the LPC verses that of YCOE, and that will lead to the development of better support and advocacy for all children, child care providers and families.

My resignation, while influenced by the above, is guided by the fact that I am no longer a consumer of child care services. I therefore do not qualify for board membership based on the law and the LPC's by-laws.

Again, it has been a pleasure to serve the children and families of Yolo County.
