**(Resolution in the Amount of \$395,959 from the National Opioid Abatement Trust II Funds)**

**WHEREAS**, on or about September 26, 2023, the Board of Supervisors for the County of Yolo adopted a budget for 2023-24 for the Health and Human Service Agency (HHS); and

**WHEREAS**, the County has received several disbursements from the Department of Health Care Services totaling \$1,286,509.30 from the National Opioid Abatement Trust II (NOAT II) funds to be used for opioid remediation activities; and

**WHEREAS**, this funding was not included in the 2023-24 adopted budget for HHS; and

**WHEREAS**, the County is requesting to include \$395,959 of Opioid settlement funding in the HHS 2023-24 HHS budget; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears in the best interest of the County, its residents, and other customers to accept the funds; and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 29130 provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Health and Human Services Agency budget for fiscal year 2023-24 is amended as follows:
