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## FIRE DISTRICT SUSTAINABILITY ONE-TIME FUNDING APPLICATION

### Eligibility:

Fire Protection Districts that are unsuccessful in their attempt at a new Proposition 218 election after July 1, 2023, are eligible to request a one-time grant of County Fire Sustainability Funds up to the maximum amount only after the Proposition 218 failure has occurred.

For Fiscal Year 2023-2024, Fire Districts that demonstrate good faith effort to conduct a Prop 218 by March 2024 may be eligible to apply for one-time funding.

### Use of Funding:

One-time grant funds are intended to support Fire District sustainability and to assist Districts in providing the necessary staffing, equipment, and resources to ensure the safety of their communities.

**Funding Summary** – Use the space below to write a justification for the need and intended use of the funding.

The Dunnigan Fire Protection District would like to request \$201146.00 to secure staffing needs at our station and complete facility projects. Currently the Dunnigan Fire Protection District responds to over 450 calls per year and requires 24/7 staffing. Our district encompasses a diverse area that includes large agricultural properties, commercial facilities, semi-dense rural residential housing, and is situated on a major interstate. This money would be used to provide a livable wage to our shift officers who are responsible for fire line decisions on all types of calls. This position requires individuals with a higher level of education and training due to the life-safety needs necessitated by the position. Currently we are not able to attract individuals with this level of education and training due to financial constraints. This jeopardizes the safety of the public as well as the safety of our employees. Dunnigan Fire Protection District prides itself on its history of bringing in entry level applicants and training them to become career firefighters, our shift officers are expected to provide this training. Dunnigan Fire Protection District is a central part of the Dunnigan community and is viewed as a community leader, further emphasizing our need to uphold a high standard for our officers in the public eye.

Portions of this funding would be utilized for a new well and a new sewer system. With 24/7 staffing our facility becomes home to many firefighters every week, minimum legal requirements dictate that our water supply and sewer systems function correctly. Our existing well and our existing sewer system are outdated and underperforming, necessitating replacement. Additionally, as a cooling and warming facility for public emergencies we require these systems to be functioning and reliable for any weather event that arises. Our community should be able to firmly know that they can rely on Dunnigan Fire Department, its employees, its equipment and its facilities.
