**Resolution No. 24-01**

**Resolution Recognizing Charles R. Mack for his Contributions to Yolo County**

**WHEREAS**, Charles R. Mack has served the County of Yolo and its residents for nearly six decades in a variety of capacities, including serving for 34 years as County Counsel from September 1, 1966 through August 31, 2000; and

**WHEREAS**, over the span of his career as County Counsel, Charles worked on many significant legal matters with a lasting effect, including (among many other examples) implementation of the Williamson Act; the incorporation of the City of West Sacramento; preparing County ordinances establishing longstanding restrictions on out-of-county water transfers, injection wells, hazardous material transportation, and other health and safety matters; leading collective bargaining with County employees and incorporating affirmative action principles and requirements into the County's personnel regulations; and implementing conflict of interest laws and regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors recognized Charles upon his retirement on August 31, 2000, for service to 25 members of the Board of Supervisors and 10 County Administrative Officers, and for attending over 1,000 Board meetings "with continued enthusiasm and dedication;" and

**WHEREAS**, following his retirement as County Counsel, Charles continued his service to the County by serving as counsel to the Assessment Appeals Board for 24 years and continuing his service on the Law Library Board of Directors, which began in 1968, for a total of 55 years; and

**WHEREAS**, those familiar with his service on the Assessment Appeals Board attest to his incredible ability to recall the details of appeals from many years prior as well as his expert knowledge of applicable laws and authorities; and

**WHEREAS**, as Charles concludes his work as counsel to Assessment Appeals Board and his service as a member of the Law Library Board of Directors, the Board of Supervisors wishes to recognize and commend Charles for his many decades of dedicated and exceptional public service; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to his service to the County, Charles has long been an active member of the Sunrise Rotary Club and he was recognized by the Episcopal Diocese of Northern California with the Bishop's Cross for his thirteen years of outstanding service to the diocese as its Chancellor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors hereby extends its sincere gratitude to Charles Mack for his many contributions to the County and the people it serves over the course of his nearly 60 years of service, including his continued service to the Assessment Appeals Board and the Law Library Board of Directors for many years following his retirement as County Counsel; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors wishes Charles continued good health and the satisfaction of enjoying retirement in the company of his family, including his wife Nancy, their daughters Susan, Sarah, and Dorothy, grandchildren Benjamin, Christopher, Katherine, Alexander, Rebecca, Elizabeth, Rowan, and great-grandchildren Rowan and Calvin.
