***RECOGNIZING SACRAMENTO REGION COMMUNITY FOUNDATION'S
40TH ANNIVERSARY***

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Region Community Foundation (the Foundation) is recognized as the trusted steward of charitable assets, a community catalyst for meaningful change, and an advocate for shaping vital impact through philanthropy in Yolo County since 1983; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation has awarded over \$225 million in grants and scholarships to support local organizations, students, and other vital projects and programs in the region; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation has hosted Big Day of Giving, the region's annual giving day that has raised over \$10 million for hundreds of local nonprofits in Yolo County and has brought together over 30,000 people to donate to causes they care about, over the past 11 years and counting; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation has grown to nearly \$200 million in charitable assets, made possible by the generosity of its fundholders and donors, who collaborate with the Foundation to make their philanthropic goals possible; and

WHEREAS, local philanthropic investment makes an impact on the causes that affect us all.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Yolo does hereby proclaim **the year 2023 as the Sacramento Region Community Foundation's 40th anniversary** and encourages all citizens to support the work of local nonprofit organizations who help the Yolo community thrive.
