(Resolution Increasing the DA’s Office’s FY23/24 Budget by \$225,000)

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney’s Consumer Fraud/Environmental unit is conducting an extensive investigation that requires an increase to the office’s services and supplies budget; and

WHEREAS, these costs were not included in the FY23/24 adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to increase the District Attorney’s Consumer Fraud/Environmental unit’s appropriation and estimated revenue (2141-2055-131046) in the amount of \$225,000; and

WHEREAS, the Consumer Fraud/Environmental unit has received an additional \$225,000 in Forfeitures & Penalties.

WHEREAS, Government Code section 29125 and 29130 authorize changes to an adopted budget in certain circumstances by a four-fifth vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Department of Financial Services is authorized to amend the estimated appropriation and revenues in fiscal year 2023-2024 as follow:
