A Resolution Increasing the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Budget by \$135,000
Allowing Yolo County Elections to Accept Federal HAVA Grant

WHEREAS, the 2023 Grand Jury report indicated a lack of security protecting staff from public threats; and

WHEREAS, Yolo County Elections is working with the General Services Department on a construction project that will increase security to its front counter and decrease potential threats from the public; and

WHEREAS, a grant has been offered through the Federal Help America Vote Act to improve election security and safety; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 as follows:
