"The contract between Partnership and Common Spirit is up for renewal, effective April 1, 2024. Both parties have been in active negotiations for the past several months. These negotiations to date have not resulted in the issuance of a new contract. The current contract expired March 31, which means approximately 17,000 Yolo County Medi-Cal patients (and many others across California) will, within 30 days, most likely need to find new primary care provision."

The public is suffering from the irreconcilable conflict of profiting from a necessity and the further for-profit conflict that shows up in legislation that blocks preventative public health measures and instead prefers the promotion of exceedingly expensive end-of-life bandaids.
