Resolution Moving Appropriations in the Sheriff’s Marine Patrol Approved Budget, for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 in the Amount of \$15,600

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff’s Office has identified a need for equipment items to conduct its law enforcement duties; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff’s Office now wishes to purchase a sponson for its 22-foot patrol boat to replace the existing deteriorating equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff’s Office requests \$15,600 in Marine Patrol budgeted funds to be moved from major object Salaries and Benefits to major object Equipment for Fiscal Year 2023-24 for these purchases; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff’s Office has anticipated that sufficient savings exists in the Approved Fiscal Year 2023-24 Salaries and Benefits budget to fund the reappropriation; and

WHEREAS, there would be no net fiscal impact to the County General Fund for Fiscal Year 2023-24 by making these adjustments; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the California Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the budget for fiscal year 2023-24 as follows:
