A RESOLUTION REVISING THE DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY CONCERNING INDUSTRIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT DETERMINATIONS OF LOCAL SAFETY EMPLOYEES OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the County of Yolo ("Agency") is a contracting agency of the California Public Employees' Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the Public Employees' Retirement Law requires that a contracting agency determine whether an employee of such agency in employment in which he/she is classified as a local safety member is disabled for purposes of the Public Employees' Retirement Law and such disability is "industrial" within the meaning of such Law; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors has determined upon legal advice that is may delegate authority under Government Code section 21173 to make such determinations to the County Administrator and Director of Human Resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors does hereby delegate to the County Administrator and Director of Human Resources authority to make applications on behalf of the Agency pursuant to Government Code section 21152(c) for disability retirement of all employees and to initiate requests for reinstatement of such employees who are retired for disability;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors does hereby delegate to the County Administrator and Director of Human Resources authority to make determinations of disability on behalf of the Agency under Government Code section 21156 and whether such disability is industrial and to certify such determinations and all other necessary information to the California Public Employees' Retirement System.
