

RESOLUTION NO. _____

(Resolution Increasing the DA’s Fiscal Year 2023-24 Budget by \$12,400 for the purpose of purchasing capital equipment using grant funding)

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney applied for and received the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement grant through the California Office of Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides funding to the High-Tech Crimes unit to manage the increasing amount of digital evidence in criminal cases and remain accredited; and

WHEREAS, the funding for this grant, awarded May 2024, was not included in FY23/24 adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to increase the District Attorney’s appropriation and estimated revenue (2010-2059-131059) in the amount of \$12,400 to install an A/C unit where evidence is kept; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 29125 and 29130 authorize changes to an adopted budget in certain circumstances by a four-fifth vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Department of Financial Services is authorized to amend the estimated appropriation and revenues in Fiscal Year 2023-2024 as follow:


