RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROPOSAL FOR FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES' FLOOD MAINTENANCE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 6 LEVEE MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES, AND DESIGNATING A REPRESENTATIVE TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, on August 18, 1975, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") adopted Resolution No. 75-97 establishing County Service Area No. 6 (hereinafter referred to as "CSA-6") to provide levee repair, operation, and maintenance activities to the areas bounded by the Knights Landing Ridge Cut and the Sacramento River, including the town of Knights Landing; and

WHEREAS, CSA-6 is a portion of the Sacramento River Flood Control Project (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Board acts as the governing body for CSA-6; and

WHEREAS, Yolo County (hereinafter referred to as the "County") is a political subdivision of the State of California with responsibility for flood maintenance and right-of-way authority of the Project facilities; and

WHEREAS, in late 2018, the California Department of Water Resources (hereinafter referred to as "DWR") created the Flood Maintenance Assistance Program (hereinafter referred to as "FMAP") which made state funding available, with no local match required, for Local Maintaining Agencies and Maintenance Areas to perform eligible maintenance activities (e.g., vegetation management, rodent abatement, gates/fencing maintenance, etc.); and

WHEREAS, the County has received FMAP program funding on an annual basis since 2019 to fund CSA-6 levee maintenance activities in an amount totaling approximately \$825,600; and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2019, the Board adopted Resolution No. 19-70 committing the County to signing an Operations, Maintenance, Repair, Rehabilitation, and Replacement agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "OMRR&R Agreement") with the Central Valley Flood Protection Board (hereinafter referred to as the "Flood Protection Board"); and

WHEREAS, the execution of an OMRR&R Agreement was required for the County to be eligible to receive FMAP funding; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2019, the OMRR&R Agreement was executed between the County and the Flood Protection Board (Yolo County Agreement No. 19-93); and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to participate in the FMAP program for the 2025 calendar year funding cycle to fund CSA-6 levee maintenance activities (hereinafter referred to as the “2025-FMAP-NA22-01 Project”); and

WHEREAS, the County is authorized to enter into an agreement with DWR and the State of California on behalf of CSA-6.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct;
2. The Manager of Natural Resources, or their designee, shall prepare the necessary data, make investigations, and take other such actions as necessary and appropriate to obtain funding for the 2025-FMAP-NA22-01 Project; and
3. Pursuant and subject to all of the terms and conditions of the Budget Act of 2024, the Board authorizes the Director of Community Services, or their designee, to execute a funding agreement with DWR, and any amendments thereto, should the County be successful in being awarded FMAP funding.
