**THIRD AMENDMENT
(BOS AGREEMENT NO. ____ - ____)**

This Third Amendment to Agreement No. 24-47 (“Third Amendment”) is made and entered into as of the last date signed below, by and between the County of Yolo (“County”) and American Medical Response West (“Contractor”), jointly referred to as the “Parties” herein.

WHEREAS, on or about December 29, 2023, the Parties entered into Agreement No. 24-47 (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, on or about February 14, 2024, the County exercised its option to extend the Agreement under the same terms and conditions via Option Letter #1; and

WHEREAS, on or about March 12, 2024, the Parties amended the Agreement via the First Amendment; and

WHEREAS, on or about May 21, 2024, the Parties further amended the Agreement via the Second Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Parties would now like to amend the Agreement, as previously amended, to:

1. Revise **Paragraph I.A** to extend the term of the Agreement through September 30, 2024; and
2. Revise **Paragraph III.B** to add funding in the amount of \$365,130 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-25 for a new contract maximum of \$973,130; and
3. Revise **Paragraph I.B.2** of **Exhibit B** to update County email addresses; and
4. Revise **Paragraph IV.B.** of **Exhibit C** to update County email address; and
5. Revise **Paragraph VIII.C.** of **Exhibit C** to update County email address; and
6. Revise **Paragraph XVII.B.** of **Exhibit C** to update County email address; and
7. Revise **Paragraph III.A.** of **Exhibit E** to update County email addresses; and
8. Revise **Exhibit F** to update reporting timeline and update County email address.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Paragraph I.A** of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The term of this Agreement shall be from **December 31, 2023 through September 30, 2024**, unless sooner terminated as provided in this Agreement.

2. **Paragraph III.B** of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Any other provision of this Agreement notwithstanding, the maximum payment obligation to Contractor through **September 30, 2024**, shall be no greater than **NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$973,680)** specified as follows:

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3. Paragraph I.B.2. of Exhibit B to the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

2. Claims/invoices shall be submitted to HHSACountsPayable@yolocounty.gov & Mario.Gallegati@yolocounty.gov.

4. Paragraph IV.B. of Exhibit C to the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. Performance Outcome Measures (POM) Report: (See Exhibit F of this Agreement)

Contractor shall maintain data and reports of performance outcome measures in compliance with the Federal and State requirements. On a quarterly basis, Contractor shall make these data and reports available to the County, as specified in Exhibit F, Performance Measures.

Submit the Performance Outcome Measures electronically via email to Mario.Gallegati@yolocounty.gov.

5. Paragraph VIII.C. of Exhibit C to the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

C. County and Contractor will maintain their own confidentiality policies and guidelines to review and follow. The location of those guidelines shall be known to all employees in all work locations. The Contractor and County agree to inform all of the employees, agents and subcontracts of the confidentiality provisions herein, including that intentionally violating the provisions of applicable laws may be punishable as a misdemeanor.

In the event that Contractor receives a request or subpoena to provide confidential information regarding any services provided pursuant to this Agreement, Contractor will notify Director immediately by telephone at (530) 661-2945 or email at Nolan.Sullivan@yolocounty.gov.

6. Paragraph XVII.B. of Exhibit C to the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. In lieu of written notice to the above addresses, any party may provide notices through the use of email provided the following email addresses are used:

7. Paragraph III.A. of Exhibit E to the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Contractor shall report, as soon as reasonably practicable, within 24 hours for potential security incidents, as defined in Title 45, CFR section 164.304, and one (1) hour for breaches of unsecured PHI as defined by Title 45, CFR section 164.402, to:

1. Herbert Lester, Yolo County Risk Manager at herbert.lester@yolocounty.gov; and

2. Lee Gerney, Yolo County Chief Technology Officer, Information Security Officer at lee.gerney@yolocounty.gov; and

3. Charles Egbert, HHS Privacy Officer at Charles.Egbert@yolocounty.gov; and

4. Katherine Barrett, HHS Behavioral Health Compliance Officer at HHSA.BHCompliance@yolocounty.gov.

8. Exhibit F to the Agreement is hereby amended to read as attached.

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
9. All attachments to this Third Amendment are incorporated herein by this reference.





Behavioral Health Mobile Crisis Services	American Medical Response	Brian Henricksen
Program Purpose	Provide rapid response for individuals experiencing a behavioral health (BH) crisis.	
Program Information	Mobile crisis services provide rapid response, individual assessment, and community-based stabilization to Medi-Cal beneficiaries who are experiencing a BH crisis. Mobile crisis services are designed to provide relief to beneficiaries experiencing a behavioral health crisis, including through de-escalation and stabilization techniques; reduce the immediate risk of danger and subsequent harm; and avoid unnecessary emergency department care, psychiatric inpatient hospitalizations, and law enforcement involvement. While mobile crisis services are intended to support an integrated approach to responding to both mental health and substance use related crises, and mobile crisis teams will be carrying, trained, and able to administer naloxone, this benefit is not intended to replace emergency medical services for medical emergencies.
