Dear Jim,

It is with mixed emotions that I submit my resignation as your appointee to the First 5 Yolo Commission, a role I've had the privilege of holding for nearly 10 years. Representing your district and serving the children of Yolo County has been one of the greatest honors of my life, and I am deeply grateful for the trust and confidence you've placed in me.

When I first joined the Commission in January 2015, Proposition 10 revenues were already on the decline. We had to act swiftly to restructure the agency and reassess our programmatic commitments to maximize impact for Yolo County's most marginalized young citizens. Together, under your leadership and that of Executive Director, Gina Daleiden, we stabilized the Commission, transforming a \$1.5 million budget into more than \$5 million annually. We also significantly strengthened the system of care for our 0-5 network. This took immense effort and courage, and I'm proud of the lasting difference we've made in the lives of Yolo County families.

As with all leadership roles, there comes a time to step back and make room for others to lead with fresh ideas and energy. This is my time to do so, and I am confident new leadership will continue to guide the Commission toward even greater achievements. It reminds me of my time with the Yolo Crisis Nursery—helping to launch, grow, and ultimately rescue the agency before stepping aside to allow others to bring their vision and drive. Today, I'm proud to see it on the verge of opening a permanent home, with fiscal stability and a broad network of support, thanks to the dedication and leadership of those who followed.

I would like my resignation to be effective no sooner than September 16 and am happy to serve until the Board of Supervisors formally accepts this letter.

Thank you again for the opportunity to serve Yolo County and its children.
