(Resolution Increasing the DA’s FY24/25 Budget by \$46,917 for security equipment)

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney’s office has determine a need to upgrade the buildings security with new interior cameras and upgraded paging system with panic button for the reception desk; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the cameras and paging system with panic button were not included in FY24/25 adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to increase appropriation and estimated revenue in the DA Seized Assets (2145-2051-131036) in the amount of \$46,917 due to funding from federal seized assets and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 29125 and 29130 authorize changes to an adopted budget in certain circumstances by a four-fifth vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Department of Financial Services is authorized to amend the estimated appropriation and revenues in fiscal year 2024-25 as follow:


