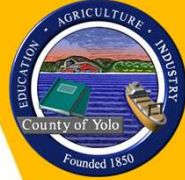

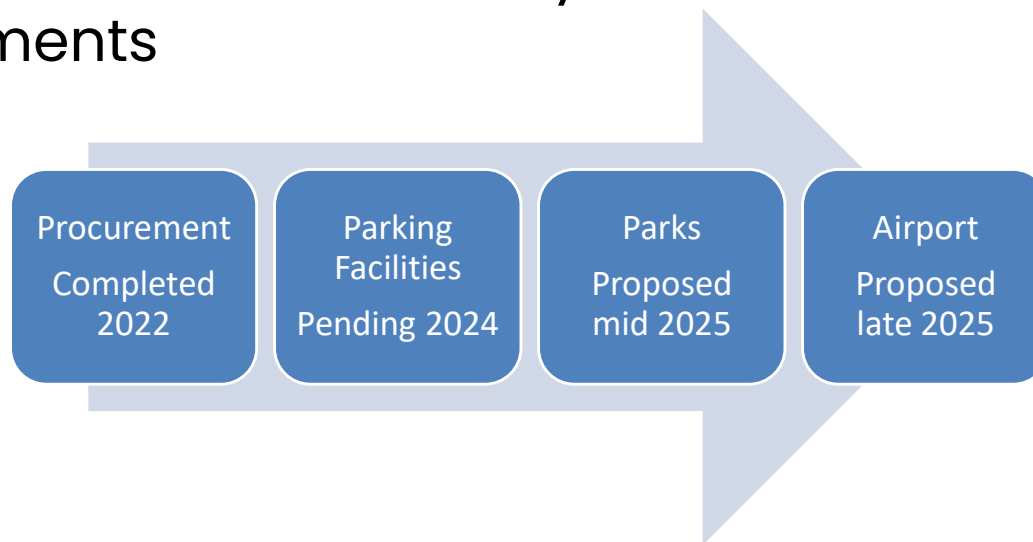

Strategy

- Repeal & replace Chapter 4 of Title 4 of the Yolo County Code
 - Adopted in 1975
 - Amended 1988
- Part of GSD's goal to modernize County codes that the department implements



Process

- Reviewed other Counties with recent updates for best practice
- Compared against relevant State Laws, including the California Vehicle Code
- Reflect County operational needs



Purpose of the Parking Code Update

- Regulate use of all off-street parking facilities operated by the County
- Ensure adequate parking space for the community, employees, and departments
- Provide for Department policy level flexibility versus rigid requirements
- Provide enforcement authority for Sheriff, Local Law Enforcement & DGS to cite and remove vehicles and related personal property
 - Allow for parking spaces for reserved uses
 - Can establish time limits
 - Can support special events
- Address modern challenges since last amendment
 - EV Charging Stations
 - New Safety issues
 - ADA law



Other Updates

- Defines when overnight parking is allowed
- Formalizes ability to issue Parking Permits
- Allow implementation of special permits to support Special Events
- Enables establishment of civil penalties through the County's Master Fee Schedule
 - Fee amounts forthcoming in future Board Item
