Project Title: 2025 Pavement Preservation Project

Applicant: Yolo County

Project Location: The project affects approximately 50 miles of County roadway in the unincorporated area and 18 miles of only re-stripping roadway from a previous project, including in the following segments:

- 19.58 miles in the Capay Valley including:
  - 0.48 miles on County Road (CR) 40A/Rumsey Canyon Rd from State Route (SR) 16 to the north end
  - 1.09 miles on CR 41 from 406' north of the Cache Creek Bridge to the north end at a cattle guard gate
  - 0.87 miles on CR 41A from CR 41 to the east end
  - 0.64 miles on CR 42 from the west end to the east end
  - 0.09 miles on CR 42B from SR 16 to the east end
  - 0.19 miles on CR 44C from SR 16 to CR 47
  - 0.64 miles on CR 45 from SR 16 to the west end
  - 1.66 miles on CR 49 from CR 59 to Hamilton Creek Bridge
  - 0.39 miles on CR 57 from SR 16 to gate on east end
  - 0.90 miles on CR 59 from SR 16 to the west end

- 4.06 miles on CR 25 from CR 93 to CR 97
- 1.49 miles on East St (CR 100) from south end to City of Woodland at CR 24C
- 0.88 miles on CR 95 from CR 24 to SR 16
- 0.36 miles on Paintridge Rd from CR 95 to west end
- 0.17 miles on Woodbridge Dr from CR 24 to south end
- 1.11 miles on Hillcrest Dr loop from CR 24
- 0.43 miles on CR 94B from CR 24 to SR 16
- 0.18 miles on CR 23A from SR 16 to CR 94B
- 0.42 miles on CR 96 from CR 20 to north end
- 1 mile on CR 96B from CR 21 to CR 19B
- 0.76 miles on CR 19B from CR 96B to CR 97A
- 0.70 miles on CR 19A from CR 97A to CR 98/SR 16
- 2 miles on CR 97A from CR 20 to CR 18

**Project Description:** The project involves road resurfacing of approximately 50 miles of Yolo County roadway, including streets in the Capay Valley, North Davis Meadows, Binning Tract, Willow Oak, State Highway 113 frontage county roads between North Davis Meadows and City of Davis, and important county collector roads between Davis and Woodland. The roadways and streets will be treated by applying an asphalt rubber cape seal or triple seal treatment on the existing road surfaces. Some roads needing more extension maintenance will require pulverization of existing asphalt surfaces, a thin asphalt leveling course and asphalt rubber cape seal on top. Asphalt rubber cape seal treatment begins with surface preparation, followed by an asphalt rubber chip seal on the existing pavement surface and finished with a microsurfacing type II surface seal on top. Triple seal treatment also begins with surface preparation and a microsurface treatment on the existing pavement surface, followed by an asphalt rubber chip seal and slurry or microsurface to complete the treatment. 18 miles on CR 99W and intersecting segments at CR 17, CR 8, and CR 1 will require re-striping of centerline striping, fog line shoulder striping, and stop bars and stop legend markings at roads intersect with CR 99W previously painted during the 2022 Pavement Preservation Project.

All construction will occur within the existing road prisms and within the existing right-of-way. No widening, right of way acquisition or increase in road capacity will occur. No trees will be removed as part of this project. The project will include a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and sediment control measures to address possible debris from construction operations.

**Exempt Status:** The project is categorically exempt from further environmental review based on Section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

**Reasons why project is exempt:** Section 15301(c) allows a “Class 1” Categorical Exemption for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination. A Class 1 exemption includes “Existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety).” The project is for resurfacing of roadway on various Yolo County roads that are currently paved and involve no increase in capacity of any existing roadway.
