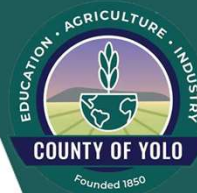

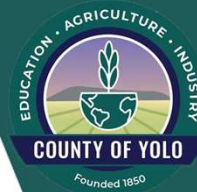


# Climate Action American Rescue Plan (ARP) Fund Allocations to Date

To date, the Yolo County Climate Action Commission and the Board of Supervisors have committed a total of **\$740,732** of the \$1,000,000 in Climate Action ARP funds.

Today, staff are presenting seven additional funding requests for the remaining **\$259,268**.

# Community Climate Action Fund

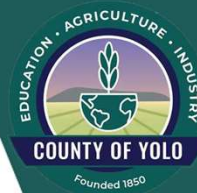
## Program Description

The fund will operate as a community micro-grant program (\$5K-\$30K).

Will support the implementation of Phase I CAAP actions through collaborative partnerships with local Community-Based Organizations (CBOs), schools, special districts, and other stakeholders.

This fund will empower local communities to take a leading role in shaping Yolo County's sustainable future and supporting CAAP implementation.

All funded projects will be completed by December 2026.

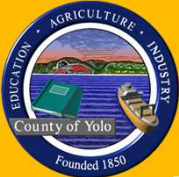

# Proposed Action

## Approve seven additional Climate Action American Rescue Plan (ARP) fund allocations totaling \$259,268:

- Staff Training (\$5,000)
- CAAP Implementation Community Engagement Revolving Fund (\$5,000)
- CivicSpark Equity and Engagement Fellow for 2025–2026 Service Year (\$31,000)
- Zero Emission Vehicle Action Plan CalTrans Grant Match (\$10,968)
- Yolo County Community Climate Action Fund (\$171,270)
