**(Authorizing the Acceptance of Grant Funding from the California Governor’s Office of
Emergency Services in the amount of \$200,000)**

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney applied for and received federal grant funding, Child Advocacy Center Program, from the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services. These funds are used to provide advocacy, outreach, and therapy to children of sexual assault within Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services has made available funding for the grant period of April 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services awarded the Yolo County District Attorney \$200,00 for the duration of the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Board authorizes the Yolo County District Attorney and/or Chief Deputy District Attorney, on its behalf, to execute the grant award agreement, including any amendments or extensions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
3. The Board understand and agrees that neither the Board of Supervisors nor the District Attorney may use any grant funds to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
