***Commending Mary Ann Limbos, MD upon her Retirement from the
Yolo County Health & Human Services Agency***

WHEREAS, Mary Ann Limbos, MD, will retire on December 19, 2024, after a long and distinguished career in public service and dedicated service to the residents of Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Limbos earned her undergraduate degree in English from Stanford University and her M.D. from the UC Davis School of Medicine; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Limbos completed a pediatrics residency and a fellowship in general academic pediatrics at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center and earned a Master of Public Health from the UCLA School of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Limbos joined the faculty of the USC School of Medicine as an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics and served as an Attending Physician in the Division of General Pediatrics at Children's Hospital Los Angeles in 1997; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Limbos joined the Yolo County California Children's Services (CCS) program as Program Medical Consultant and Deputy Health Officer in June 2016; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Limbos has consistently demonstrated exceptional foresight in anticipating and addressing the needs of Yolo County CCS clients while promoting effective communication and collaboration with her colleagues; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Limbos played a leadership role in creating the Yolo County Foster Care Hub program to improve pediatric medical care access for children placed in the Yolo County foster care system; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Limbos, in her role as Yolo County Deputy Health Officer, provided critical information to Yolo County residents about the COVID-19 virus and ways to prevent infection from the beginning of the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Limbos is a healthcare professional who has demonstrated unparalleled dedication to the well-being of our community during the most challenging times in recent history.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo does hereby honors and commends Dr. Mary Ann Limbos for her eight years of service to the County of Yolo and wishes her a long, happy, healthy, and productive retirement.
