Program Name	YCRC Youth Restorative Justice – Diversion Referrals
Program Information	A second chance for any youth involved in the juvenile justice system.
Program Purpose	A different approach to accountability that is voluntary, confidential, and that helps the referred party (offender) understand the impacts of their actions by concentrating on the real actions to repair harm without punishment.
How much did we do?	
Quantity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 74 total referrals to Youth RJ Program <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 10 youth diverted by the Woodland PD ○ 64 youth diverted by the Probation Department
How well did we do?	
Quality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Average (median) length of time between date we received the referral and closure meeting/ (joint conference if no closure meeting): 5 months • 98% of respondents were satisfied with the program <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 0% - not satisfied with the program ○ 2% - neutral (1 response)
Is anyone better off?	
Outcome	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 51 of youth successfully completed the program (69% of referrals) • Of youth that did not complete the program: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 12 Declined (16% of total referrals) ○ 5 Were not able to contact (7% of total referrals) ○ 6 Inappropriate/Incomplete (8% of total referrals) • 90% of youth entering the program were referred for the first time, 7 cases were for youth on a repeat referral. • 20% of cases had victims/affected parties participate (10 cases) • 80% of cases had a surrogate/indirectly affected party participate (41 cases)
