Dear Dirk,

At our December 3rd City Council meeting, the City approved the East Street Underground Utility District and is now considered an active project according to the PG&E Rule 20A guidelines. Based on discussions at the staff level, our understanding is that the County is not pursuing a utility undergrounding project and the County is willing to donate approximately \$962,564 in PG&E Rule 20A credits to the City for use on our undergrounding project.

The City's undergrounding District includes two parcels that are owned by the County. The two parcels are located at 213 Third Street (APN 005-204-023) and 740 Court Street (APN 005-221-005). Given that the County is donating almost one million in PG&E Rule 20A credits to the City, the City is willing to pay for any onsite undergrounding costs (or City fees) to connect the County parcels to this undergrounding project should the ultimate project include any of the County properties.

Please note that the City adopted a fairly large number of streets in our undergrounding District and we will likely not be able to underground all utility lines within the approved area. It is possible that the City may choose not to underground the overhead utility lines adjacent to the County parcels. Please check in with the City before incurring any costs related to the undergrounding project.
