(Resolution Authorizing Acceptance and Execution of Agreement for HIV Surveillance Program Administered by the California Department of Public Health in the Amount of \$77,685)

WHEREAS, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has authority to grant funds for the HIV Surveillance Program (HSP) under Health and Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, CDPH Office of AIDS (OA) is the lead agency responsible for coordinating state programs, services and activities related to HIV and Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS); and

WHEREAS, CDPH has approved HSP grant funds for the purpose of administering the HSP and to ensure the implementation of HIV surveillance activities in support of the goals of California’s Ending the Epidemics: Addressing HIV, Hepatitis C Virus, and Sexually Transmitted Infections in California Integrated Statewide Strategic Plan in the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Chair of the Yolo County Board of Supervisors is authorized to accept and execute CDPH Agreement No. 24-10326 (“Agreement”) to receive HSP funds in the amount of \$77,685 for the period of July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2029.
2. The Yolo County Deputy Director of General Services/Manager of Procurement, or designee, is authorized to execute any non-financial extensions or amendments to the Agreement upon approval as to form by County Counsel.
3. The Director of the Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency, or designee, is authorized to execute any fiscal and program forms and reports required under this Agreement, including forms and reports required under any extensions or amendments thereto.
