Authorizing Fiscal Year 2025-26 Funding Application to the California State Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways and Authorization to Participate in the Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid Program

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office desires to participate in the Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid Program administered by the California State Department of Parks and Recreation to help support the provision of necessary law enforcement services on the waterways of Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, Harbors and Navigation Code 663.7 and California Code of Regulations Section 6593 together require that certain assurance be provided as a condition of receiving the funding; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing appears appropriate to this Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, as follows:

1. The Yolo County Sheriff's Office is authorized to apply, on behalf of Yolo County, to the California State Parks Boating and Waterways Division for Fiscal Year 2025-26 funding, and Tom A. Lopez, Yolo County Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator, is to have signature authority on all program-related documents.

2. The County is authorized to participate in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Boating Safety and Financial Aid Program, that it shall expend on boating safety programs not less than an amount equal to 100% of the amount received by the County from personal property taxes on vessels, and that the County Auditor is authorized to certify the amount of prior year vessel taxes received by the County.
