Authorize the District Attorney to apply for funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services in the amount of \$51,136

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney is applying for federal funds from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Program. These funds will be utilized in the High-Tech Crimes Unit remain an accredited lab; and

WHEREAS, the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Program grant is non-competitive and is the final year in a 5 year grant cycle; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has made funding available for the grant period of April 1, 2025, to March 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services made \$51,136 available in federal funding for the duration of the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Board authorizes the Yolo County District Attorney and/or Chief Deputy District Attorney, on its behalf, to apply for and execute the grant award agreement, including any amendments or extension necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
3. The Board understands and agrees that neither the Board of Supervisors nor the District Attorney may use any grant funds to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
