# Engage Empower Implement (EEI) Program and Yolo County Objectives



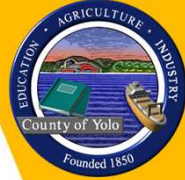
## Thriving Residents

- The Engage Empower Implement (EEI) grant opportunity offered by the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) to engage in vital community-based outreach and engagement efforts as they relate to equity, economy, and the environment.
- Yolo County also aims to reduce disparities and enhance quality of life by improving access to essential services for our most vulnerable residents including children, youth, and families.
- **Through the EEI grant opportunity, Yolo County will be able to provide direct funding to support youth engagement services, local services feedback, and community participation through partnership and collaboration to address these needs.**



# Grant proposal and Partnerships

The Application Narrative (Att. B.) outlines the proposal as well as the roles and responsibilities of each Community Based Organization (CBO) partner:

- **The County of Yolo:**

- Will be the grant administrator and support of the CBO partners to sustain effective outreach avenues.
- With this grant award, the County aims to achieve higher service delivery and improve the access to quality opportunities through these partnerships.

- **Health Education Council (HEC):**

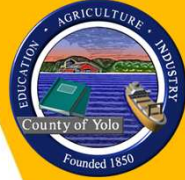
- Enhance outreach to target disinvested neighborhoods in West Sacramento.
- HEC will leverage its current resources to engage with residents to better understand the causes and resident-identified solutions to the disproportionate health inequities and potential issues of mobility to access care.
- HEC will listen to identify opportunities for addressing barriers to healthier communities.

- **RISE, Inc.:**

- Will assist with audience identification in Yolo County, particularly, identifying youth in rural areas and connecting them to engagement activities such as After-School enrichment programs, Leadership Workshops, and College Exploration sessions.
- These engagement activities would be an avenue to collaborate with Yolo County Office of Education in a joint effort to empower youth residents across the County with these targeted service efforts.

- **The Yolo County Office of Education (YCOE):**

- A key stakeholder who will perform service efforts that reinforce and expand RISE, Inc.'s outreach and engagement activities.



## Funding Sources and Final Budget Request

- Yolo County's proposal was approved on November 14<sup>th</sup> with the budget request below.

### Summary Budget Table

<b>Partner</b>	<b>Total Budget Request</b>
County of Yolo	\$20,000
Health Education Council	\$104,119
RISE, Inc.	\$90,500
Yolo County Office of Education	\$63,000
<b>Final Budget Request Amount=</b>	<b>\$277,619</b>

- A majority portion of this funding, \$252,000, would be reimbursed from the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).
- The remaining amount of \$25,619 would be received as a lump sum from SACOG directly.
