

RESOLUTION NO. 25-_____

(A Resolution Increasing the Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Budget for the Assessor’s Office by \$8,500 for the purchase of a KIP 720 wide format scanner.)

WHEREAS, the Assessor’s Office (Office) receives, on an ongoing basis, large paper building plans (Plans) from permitting agencies as part of the assessment process; and

WHEREAS, the timely digitization and integration of these Plans into the Office’s appraisal database is essential to maintaining efficient workflows, reducing paper storage needs, and ensuring accessibility for appraisers and support staff; and

WHEREAS, Appraisers rely on these Plans to analyze property characteristics, verify construction details, and ensure assessments are fair and equitable in accordance with California property tax laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Office has monies available in unearned revenue and restricted fund balance as the result of a 2019 SSCAP (State Supplementation for County Assessor’s Program) grant that has been fully paid to the county, which can be used for this acquisition; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for fiscal year 2024-2025 as follows:
