

RESOLUTION NO. _____

(Resolution Increasing the DA’s FY24/25 Budget by \$39,145 for TruNarc)

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney’s office has determined the need to purchase TruNarc, a handheld narcotics analyzer to identify drugs and other controlled substances in the field. The device will be kept at the Yolo County Jail but accessible to all local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the handheld narcotic analyzer was not included in FY24/25 adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to increase appropriation and estimated revenue in the DA Seized Assets (2145-2051-131036) in the amount of \$39,145 due to funding from state seized assets; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 29125 and 29130 authorize changes to an adopted budget in certain circumstances by a four-fifth vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Department of Financial Services is authorized to amend the estimated appropriation and revenues in fiscal year 2024-25 as follow:


