Commending Nolan Sullivan for his Outstanding Service to Yolo County

WHEREAS, Nolan Sullivan began working for Yolo County as a Support Services Supervisor in the then-Department of Employment and Social Services, and rose through the ranks to become the Director of the Service Centers Branch in 2016. Nolan became the Director of the Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency in June 2022; and

WHEREAS, Nolan attained a Bachelor's Degree at the California State University – Chico and a Master's Degree in Public Administration at the University of San Francisco. He is a California State Association of Counties' Credentialed County Senior Executive, with management and leadership certifications from the University of California at Davis; and

WHEREAS, Nolan has valiantly served his community in a wide variety of capacities for more than twenty years, including as a school board and city council member for Vacaville. He is a regular volunteer with several children and education focused nonprofits including the Vacaville Public Education Foundation and the United Way of Woodland. Nolan was essential to the COVID-19 pandemic response efforts in Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, Nolan has been a key player in many community initiatives including the Yolo Basic Income Project, the Crisis Now project, the establishment of 211 Yolo as a community resource, has served as a member of the Community Corrections Partnership, and has worked closely with the Local Behavioral Health Board. He has excelled in leadership roles in Statewide and County workgroups, as a Director of the state-wide County Welfare Directors Association and a member of the Partnership HealthPlan of California finance committee while juggling many other responsibilities and priorities; and

WHEREAS, Nolan has accepted the call to serve as Director of Sonoma County's Department of Health Services; and

WHEREAS, Nolan is a dedicated health and human services professional who has employed collaborative approaches that improve client services and outcomes and demonstrated unparalleled dedication to the well-being of our community during the most challenging times in recent history.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo does hereby honor and commend Nolan Sullivan for more than 17 years of service to the County of Yolo and wishes him success in his future endeavors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors calls upon Yolo County residents to join in recognizing and expressing their appreciation for the dedication and service of Nolan Sullivan.
