**Resolution No. 25-30**

***Proclaiming April 12, 2025 as the Oddest Day of the Year***

**WHEREAS**, the Davis Odd Fellows Lodge was chartered and instituted in April 1870 and is the oldest continuously operating organization in the Davis city limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Davis Odd Fellows is the largest Lodge in North America with nearly 400 active members and growing; and

**WHEREAS**, the original name of the Davis Odd Fellows Lodge was the Yolo Lodge, as it was founded prior to the incorporation of Davisville and the founding of the University of California at Davis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Davis Odd Fellows hosts many events to benefit the community, including Odd Fellows Bingo, Breakfast with the Bunny, Breakfast with Santa, A Taste of Davis, the Davis Chocolate Festival, the Davis Classic Film Festival, Thursday Live!, Picnic Day Pancake Breakfast, the Natalie Corona Odd Fellows Scholarship, and the Zombie Bike Ride; and

**WHEREAS**, Odd Fellows committees engage in highway clean-up, holiday caroling and bell ringing, and helping frail seniors in their homes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Odd Fellows Community Support Committee provides tens of thousands of dollars every year to support local charitable organizations and to help foster children as well as young adults who have recently "aged out" of the foster care system; and

**WHEREAS**, over the years the Davis Odd Fellows have provided hundreds of thousands of dollars and thousands of volunteer hours to help others; and

**WHEREAS**, Odd Fellowship strives to elevate Human Character through Friendship, Love, and Truth, which are represented in the three-interlocking links of the Odd Fellows' logo and serve as the foundational beliefs of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of Yolo County hereby commends the Davis Odd Fellows Lodge for their 155 years of service to the community and hereby proclaims April 12, 2025 as the Oddest Day of the Year.
