(Resolution to Transfer \$17,821 in DA FY24/25 Appropriations from Contribution to Fund Balance to Capital Assets for a License Plate Reader)

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney’s office has determine a need to purchase a new license plate reader; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the License Plate Reader is not included in FY24/25 adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to move appropriation in the amount of \$17,821 from Contribution to Fund Balance to Capital Asset Equipment (2146 2059 131055); and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 29125 and 29130 authorize changes to an adopted budget in certain circumstances by a four-fifth vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

2. The Department of Financial Services is authorized to amend the estimated appropriation and revenues in fiscal year 2024-25 as follow:


