<b>Program Purpose</b>	To provide residential treatment services for eligible Seriously Mentally Ill (SMI) adults referred by Yolo County Health & Human Services, to reduce psychiatric hospital stays, reduce Institute for Mental Disease (IMD) placements, and reduce risk of homelessness for those served. <b>Goal #1:</b> Reduction in utilization of higher levels of care both while in the program and after graduating the program. <b>Goal #2:</b> Reduction in severity of psychiatric symptom presentation.	
<b>Program Information</b>	Long-term residential (typically 1 – 2 years) treatment program in a rural setting, offering cooperative living and working skill development opportunities, assisting individuals to transition from highly structured treatment environments to less structured independent living situations.

2.4	% of clients who were not hospitalized in the quarter	
2.5	% of clients who were not incarcerated in the quarter	
2.6	% of clients with an identified substance use disorder who participated in substance use programming in the quarter	
<b>PM3: Is anyone better off?</b>		
3.1	% of clients served in the quarter who had no psychiatric hospital/health facility readmission within 6 months of a previous admission	
3.2	% of clients who were working, began working, were volunteering, began volunteering or were in school, began school in the quarter

- Submit October 31<sup>st</sup> for the period of July 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>
- Submit January 31<sup>st</sup> for the period of October 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>
- Submit April 30<sup>th</sup> for the period of January 1<sup>st</sup> through March 30<sup>th</sup>
- Submit July 31<sup>st</sup> for the period of April 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup>
