**RESOLUTION NO. 25 - \_\_\_\_\_**

(Resolution Authorizing Grant Application for Department of Resources  
Recycling and Recovery Local Enforcement Agency Grant Program)

**WHEREAS**, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

**WHEREAS**, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

**WHEREAS**, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; and

**WHEREAS**, grant funds are available from CalRecycle for local enforcement agencies to support solid waste permitting and enforcement activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Yolo County Community Services Department, Environmental Health Division, plans to seek such funds; and

**WHEREAS**, if awarded, the County of Yolo ("County") will enter into necessary grant agreements with CalRecycle; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears in the best interests of the County and its residents so submit the necessary grant applications for these funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals, and each of them, are true and correct.
2. The Board hereby authorizes the Director of Environmental Health ("Director") to submit grant applications on behalf of the County of Yolo.
3. If a grant application is approved, the Director is authorized to accept the grant funds and to enter into and execute all necessary documents to secure grant funds and to implement and carry out approved grant projects.
4. This authorization is effective for a period of five (5) years, from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2030.
