***Honoring and Commending West Sacramento Resident Quinn White for her
Exemplary Feat in Athletics***

WHEREAS, Former River City High School student athlete Quinn White has been an incredible representative of Yolo County, making it to the State Championship final in both 100-meter hurdles and long jump; and

WHEREAS, Quinn finished second in both events, becoming the fastest 100-meter hurdler in Sacramento preparatory school history and becoming the second fastest time in San-Joaquin Section history at 13.59 seconds; and

WHEREAS, Quinn achieved this while being an honor student with a 4.3 GPA, and will be attending UC San Diego this fall to study Psychology; and

WHEREAS, Quinn fostered acceptance in a hostile climate, advocating for a fellow athlete who is transgender despite public outcry, sharing second place in long jump with them.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors honors and commends Quinn White for her exemplary feat in athletics and her acceptance of fellow athletes, recognizing her as a model representative of West Sacramento and Yolo County at large.
