Authorize the District Attorney to apply for the Victim/Witness Assistance grant from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney will be applying for federal/state funds from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Victim/Witness Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has not yet released the RFP or Funding for the Victim/Witness Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services requires proof of authority with each grant application; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services may release RFP with required submittal date of grant before the next board meeting of August 26, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney will come back to the Board of Supervisors with funding amount and grant period once the RFP has been released.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Board authorizes the Yolo County District Attorney and/or Chief Deputy District Attorney, on its behalf, to apply for and execute the grant award agreement, including any amendments or extension necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
3. The Board understands and agrees that neither the Board of Supervisors nor the District Attorney may use any grant funds to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
