

YOLO COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 25-_____

(Fifth Amendment to Agreement No. 4151 with Patrol Solutions relating to Security Services)

THIS Fifth Amendment to Agreement No. 4151 is made and entered into as of the 26th day of August 2025, by and between the County of Yolo, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), and Patrol Solutions, LLC, a California limited liability company, dba Patrol Solutions (“Contractor”), who agree as follows.

WHEREAS, on or about December 1, 2021, the parties entered into an agreement for Contractor to provide security services at various locations throughout the County (Yolo County Agreement No. 4151); and

WHEREAS, on or about July 12, 2022, the parties amended Agreement No. 4151 to extend the current contract term for one additional year through June 30, 2023, with options to renew the Agreement for up to four additional one-year terms and to increase the maximum compensation, effective July 1, 2022, to \$250,000 per fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, on or about October 10, 2023, the parties entered into an agreement to extend the current contract term for one additional year through June 30, 2024, with option to renew the Agreement for up to three additional one-year terms and in increase the maximum compensation, effective July 1, 2023, to \$255,000 per fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, on or about July 9, 2024, the parties entered into an Amended and Restated Agreement No. 4151 (Yolo County Agreement No. 24-198), also considered the Third Amendment to Agreement No. 4151, to extend the current contract term for one additional year through June 30, 2025, with option to renew the Agreement for up to two additional on-year terms and increase the maximum compensation, effective July 1, 2024, to \$800,000 per fiscal year with CPI adjustments to the maximum compensation for the remaining optional extension terms; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 6, 2025, the parties further amended Agreement No. 4151 (Fourth Amendment – Yolo County Agreement No. 25-108) to increase the annual contract amount not to exceed \$900,000 for fiscal year 2024-25 due to additional temporary services to enhance security at certain County locations; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to further amend Agreement No. 4151 to confirm extension of the contract term for one additional year through June 30, 2026, with option to renew the Agreement for up to one additional one year term, and increase the maximum compensation, effective July 1, 2025, to \$973,000 for fiscal year 2025-26; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Effective July 1, 2025, **Paragraph III.** of Agreement No. 4151, as amended and restated in Agreement No. 24-198 (“the Agreement”), is hereby amended to read as follows:

III. COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES

- A. For the services described in Paragraph I of the Agreement, and subject to the condition that the services have been completed in a manner satisfactory to the Director or his/her designee, Contractor shall be compensated as follows:

Contractor agrees to provide services as specified in the Agreement, including at the locations specified in Paragraph 1 of the Agreement, at the rates set forth in Exhibit C thereto (Cost Proposal) through the term of the Agreement.

Provided, however, that in no event shall the total amount of compensation to be paid to Contractor for the services required by this Agreement exceed Nine Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand Dollars (\$973,000) per County fiscal year (July 1-June 30) (“Maximum Compensation”).

- B. **CPI Adjustment for Optional Extension Term (FY 2026-27).** As provided in Paragraph VIII.A, of the Agreement, the Director may approve one additional one-year extension of this Agreement from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. The Contractor may request to increase the Monthly Fees in Exhibit C and the Maximum Compensation provided in this Fifth Amendment by (i) the California Consumer Price Index (CPI-W, US City Average, All Items; NSA) or (ii) 5.0%, whichever is lower, for the one-year extension terms by submitting such request to County at least 30 days prior to July 1, 2026.

- C. **No Expense Reimbursement.** Contractor shall not be entitled to reimbursement for any expenses.

2. The Parties further confirm that they have exercised the option to the extend the Agreement, for one additional year pursuant to **Paragraph VIII., subsection A.,** of the Agreement. The Agreement now expires on June 30, 2026, subject to the remaining one-year option to extend through June 30, 2027.
3. Except as specifically amended hereinabove, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect according to its terms.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Fifth Amendment to Agreement No. 4151, as amended by Amended and Restated Agreement No. 4151 (Yolo County Agreement No. 24-198), as of the day and year first written above.


