WHEREAS, Winters Healthcare was founded in 2000 by a group of concerned citizens, farmers, seniors, and business owners in Winters seeking to improve the health of all persons in the community, including underserved populations in southwestern Yolo County and the surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, over the past 25 years, Winters Healthcare has grown from a small clinic into a comprehensive health center offering medical, dental, behavioral health, and supportive services to thousands of patients each year; and

WHEREAS, Winters Healthcare has remained steadfast in its commitment to treating the whole person, addressing not only immediate medical needs but also the social and environmental factors that impact health and well-being; and

WHEREAS, Winters Healthcare has played an essential role in improving access to care for underserved populations, promoting health equity, and ensuring that no one is turned away due to inability to pay; and

WHEREAS, Winters Healthcare is a champion of inclusivity, ensuring that every individual—regardless of background or circumstance—receives patient-centered care in an environment free of discrimination and intolerance; and

WHEREAS, in 2024 Winters Healthcare began operating in the Wihne da Puchuma de Kewe Capay Valley Health and Community Center, bringing a full array of primary care options, dental, behavioral health, and pharmaceutical services under one roof for the first time in Esparto; and

WHEREAS, in 2025 Winters Healthcare was the recipient of the Yolo County Public Health Hero Award in recognition of their ongoing partnership with the Yolo County Immunizations Program, ensuring safe, effective, and equitable vaccine access across Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, through 25 years of service, Winters Healthcare has earned the trust, respect, and gratitude from patients, making an enduring impact on generations of families; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby congratulates Winters Healthcare on the occasion of its 25th anniversary, honors its outstanding contributions to public health and community well-being, and extends its best wishes for continued success in the years to come.
