Resolution No. 25-118

Recognizing September 21, 2025 as “Chalk Walk and Roll Day” in Yolo County

WHEREAS, the State of California recognizes the month of September as Pedestrian Safety Month to raise awareness of pedestrian rights, responsibilities, and safety across the state; and

WHEREAS, Yolo County is committed to supporting programs and initiatives that promote the health, safety, and wellbeing of its residents, particularly in active transportation modes such as walking, biking, and rolling (e.g., wheelchairs, strollers, etc.); and

WHEREAS, pedestrian safety is a shared responsibility that requires the active participation of community members, schools, law enforcement agencies, and local government to reduce pedestrian-related injuries and fatalities; and

WHEREAS, “Chalk, Walk and Roll Day” is a community-based pedestrian safety initiative that encourages children, families, and residents to use sidewalk chalk art as a creative and engaging way to promote awareness of safe walking and rolling behaviors in their neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, this initiative is led by the Yolo County Traffic Safety Program, in collaboration with the Yolo County Library, to foster safe, healthy, and connected communities by engaging children and families through fun, educational activities centered on pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, Yolo County will host its first “Chalk, Walk and Roll Day” on September 21, 2025, a creative and educational pedestrian safety event where participants will use sidewalk chalk art to express and promote safe walking and rolling habits; and

WHEREAS, this inaugural event will take place at the Mary L. Stephens – Davis Branch Library of the Yolo County Library, offering children, families and residents a fun and engaging opportunity to learn about pedestrian safety in a community- centered environment;

WHEREAS, Chalk, Walk and Roll Day” supports broader countywide efforts to reduce traffic-related injuries and create a culture of safety through public outreach, education, and cross-agency collaboration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims September 21, 2025, as “Chalk Walk and Roll Day” in Yolo County, in recognition of California’s Pedestrian Safety Month, and encourages residents of all ages to participate in the day’s activities to promote safe, walkable, and vibrant communities.
