**Resolution Designating the Intersection of County Road 99D and Barry Road north of the City of Davis, as a Multi-Way Stop Intersection**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority provided by Section 21100 of the California Vehicle Code, local authorities may adopt rules and regulations by ordinance or resolution to regulate traffic by means of official traffic control devices meeting the requirements of Vehicle Code Section 21400; and

WHEREAS, the California Vehicle Code Sections 21354 and 21355 authorizes local authorities to designate certain intersections for placement of stop signs; and

WHEREAS, Yolo County Code, Title 4, Chapter 3, Section 4-3.301 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, by Resolution, to designate certain intersections as “stop intersections” and to erect the placement of stop signs at one or more entrances thereto; and

WHEREAS, the intersection of County Road 99D and Barry Road is a 3-way intersection that currently has a stop sign at the east bound leg of Barry Road; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors have considered the installation of stop signs in the north and southbound directions on County Road 99D provides for the orderly movement of left turning traffic from Barry Road onto County Road 99D; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that the establishment of a multi-way stop at the intersection of County Road 99D and Barry Road will improve conditions for motorists and bicycles using the intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo that the following location is designated as a multi-way Stop Intersection:

County Road 99D and Barry Road

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Yolo County Department of Community Services is authorized and directed to place and maintain such stop signs at the entrances to this intersection as required to properly indicate and carry out the provisions of this Resolution pursuant to the California Vehicle Code Section 21351.
