45 days is a very short time to provide a review the well permitting process and supporting evidence of impact on the existing community.

We are all aware of the moneyed interests moving into areas and disrupting established systems with the promise of benefits that rarely, if ever, arise. However, when those impacts take lifetimes to recuperate or rebalance, as impacting the water table will do in a rural community, care and caution must override financial concerns.

The fact that the land is already being prepared for planting before approval has been received implies a disregard for the land - since it will take years for soil to recover. It also makes one wonder if a county decision has been made despite the moratorium.

I support the Community Alliance for Family Farmers (CAFF) team's request for a ten month extension to allow a reasonable time to document the impact on neighboring farms and the extended community, *and review the well permitting process.*
