Dear Supervisors,

I am writing to urge you to extend the moratorium on new well permits in the Focus Areas in Yolo County.

At the Board of Supervisors Meeting on August 26 which I attended, you voted unanimously to implement a 45 day moratorium on new well permits in the Focus Areas. After listening to the various testimonies on the evidence of water depletion in the wells in the Focus Areas, I sensed a strong commitment from you that we "have to get this right."

I understand various proposals have been brought forth for your consideration. I strongly urge you to extend the moratorium for the full legal limit in order to collect the data on the impacts of increased water extraction from wells in the Focus Areas. It takes time to collect the essential data for making informed, intelligent decisions that will ensure we support equitable and sustainable agriculture in Yolo County.
