We, the residents of Binning Tract, are writing to advocate strongly for expedited installation of a stop sign at the intersection of Barry Road and County Road 99D. Furthermore, we respectfully request your consideration of a second crucial stop sign at the Sharon Avenue/County Road 99D intersection. These measures are essential to enhance the safety of our community, particularly given the inherent dangers posed by current traffic conditions on this stretch of County Road 99D, also known as John Jones Road. By approving these stop signs, you will greatly enhance the safety of our community.

Our concerns are deeply rooted in the persistent issue of excessive vehicle speeds on County Road 99D, which has a speed limit of 55 mph across the intersections of both Sharon and Barry Roads. Data collected from radar feedback signs from April 28 to July 6, 2025 clearly demonstrates a consistent pattern of high approach speeds that exceed safe levels for a residential access road.
