WHEREAS, Meals on Wheels Yolo County not only provides nutrition but also offers critical wellness checks, friendly visits, and peace of mind for families who know their loved ones are cared for; and

WHEREAS, Meals on Wheels Yolo County is the only provider in Yolo County that delivers dependable, freshly prepared, ready-to-eat meals for seniors; and

WHEREAS, the success of Meals on Wheels Yolo County is made possible through the dedication of its staff, the generosity of its volunteers, and the continued support of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors recognizes the essential role Meals on Wheels Yolo County plays in advancing health equity, reducing senior isolation, and strengthening community bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes the 50th Anniversary of Meals on Wheels Yolo County and commends its extraordinary contributions to food security and profound impact on the lives of our residents and expresses deep gratitude to all who have contributed to its mission.
