**Resolution Designating the Intersection of County Road 99W and
County Road 1 North of the Town of Dunnigan, as a Multi-Way
Stop Intersection**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority provided by Section 21100 of the California Vehicle Code, local authorities may adopt rules and regulations by ordinance or resolution to regulate traffic by means of official traffic control devices meeting the requirements of Vehicle Code Section 21400; and

WHEREAS, the California Vehicle Code Sections 21354 and 21355 authorizes local authorities to designate certain intersections for placement of stop signs; and

WHEREAS, Yolo County Code, Title 4, Chapter 3, Section 4-3.301 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, by Resolution, to designate certain intersections as “stop intersections” and to erect the placement of stop signs at one or more entrances thereto; and

WHEREAS, the intersection of County Road 99W and County Road 1 (also known as County Line Road) is a 4-way intersection that currently has stop signs on the westbound and eastbound legs of County Road 1; and

WHEREAS, the Colusa County Department of Public Works, in coordination with Yolo County, has received concerns from residents and roadway users regarding traffic safety at this intersection; and

WHEREAS, the county line runs approximately at the centerline of County Road 1, thus Colusa County retains jurisdiction over the southbound intersection approach, and Yolo County retains jurisdiction over the northbound intersection approach; and

WHEREAS, an engineering traffic study was conducted by the Colusa County Department of Public Works in accordance with the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CAMUTCD), and the study determined that the intersection meets warrants for multi-way stop control based on traffic volumes, collision history, and sight distance considerations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Colusa County passed Colusa County Resolution No. 25-037 to authorize the installation of a multi-way stop at the intersection on September 23, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo acknowledges the actions taken in Colusa County Resolution No. 25-037 and finds that the establishment of a multi-way stop at the intersection of County Road 99W and County Road 1 will enhance public safety and improve traffic operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo that the following location is designated as a multi-way stop intersection:

County Road 99W and County Road 1

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Yolo County Department of Community Services is authorized and directed to place and maintain such stop signs at the entrances to this intersection as required to properly indicate and carry out the provisions of this Resolution pursuant to the California Vehicle Code Section 21351; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Colusa County Department of Public Works will initially install all signs and striping necessary to establish the multi-way stop, and Yolo County will maintain associated signs and striping within the intersection going forward in accordance with Yolo County Resolution No. 61-155.
