

RESOLUTION NO. 25-037

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF COLUSA AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A MULTI-WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF OLD HIGHWAY 99 AND COUNTY LINE ROAD

WHEREAS, the intersection of Old Highway 99 and County Line Road currently operates under two-way stop control, with existing stop signs controlling eastbound and westbound traffic on County Line Road; and

WHEREAS, the Colusa County Department of Public Works, in coordination with Yolo County, has received concerns from residents and roadway users regarding traffic safety at this intersection; and

WHEREAS, an engineering traffic study was conducted in accordance with the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CA MUTCD), and the study determined that the intersection meets warrants for multi-way stop control based on traffic volumes, collision history, and sight distance considerations; and

WHEREAS, Yolo County is concurrently pursuing authorization to install a stop sign on the northbound approach of Old Highway 99, and Colusa County retains jurisdiction over the southbound approach; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that the installation of a multi-way stop at this intersection will enhance public safety and improve traffic operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Colusa hereby authorizes and directs the Colusa County Public Works Department to install an R1-1 Stop Sign and all necessary pavement markings and signage to control **southbound traffic on Old Highway 99 at County Line Road**, thereby converting the intersection to a multi-way stop-controlled intersection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Works Director is authorized to coordinate with Yolo County for the concurrent installation of the corresponding stop sign on the northbound approach within their jurisdiction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Works Director is authorized to accept a check in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) from Midstream Energy Partners as payment for the cost of the installation of the multi-way stop sign control.


