Resolution Increasing Appropriations in the Sheriff's Patrol Approved Budget in the Amount of \$73,282 for Fiscal Year 2025-2026

WHEREAS the Sheriff's Office has identified a need for additional equipment items to conduct its law enforcement duties; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office, as a sub-recipient of Yolo County, was awarded \$73,282 in Fiscal Year 2024 Homeland Security Grant Funds, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office now wishes to purchase seven APX 8000 Dual Band Radios to replace existing aged equipment; and

WHEREAS, there would be no net fiscal impact to the County General Fund for Fiscal Year 2025-26 by making these adjustments; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the California Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the budget for fiscal year 2025-26 as follows:
