**(Authorizing the District Attorney to apply for funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services in the amount of \$200,000)**

**WHEREAS**, the Yolo County District Attorney is applying for federal and state grant funding, Child Advocacy Center Program, from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services. These funds are used to provide advocacy, outreach, and therapy to children of sexual assault within Yolo County; and

**WHEREAS**, this will be the 4<sup>th</sup> year of a 5 year grant cycle, making the Child Advocacy Center grant non-competitive; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has made available funding for the grant period of April 1, 2026, to March 31, 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has made \$112,600 available in federal funding and \$87,400 available in state funding for a grant total of \$200,000 for the duration of the grant period.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Board authorizes the Yolo County District Attorney and/or Chief Deputy District Attorney on its behalf, to apply and execute the grant award agreement, including any amendments or extensions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
3. The Board understand and agrees that neither the Board of Supervisors nor the District Attorney may use any grant funds to supplant expenditures controlled by this body
