I would like to submit this comment for the upcoming Board of Supervisors meeting:

Dear Yolo County Board of Supervisors,

I am emailing to submit a comment on the growing traffic safety concerns on County Road 102, specifically the stretch of the county road between Knights Landing and Woodland. I understand CHP has been conducting recent focused spot checks, but I would like to stress that this is not enough. Drivers on County Road 102 have long been reckless, from speeding to driving under the influence, and very little has been done to prevent car accidents and subsequent fatalities.

Frankly, the lack of county-level concern is disappointing and concerning. Community members in Knights Landing do not feel heard or as though our voices matter, despite talks of change happening for years within our community and with county officials. There have been too many accidents, too many fatalities— and considering how difficult it is for ambulances to reach our area because of the distance, change must come quickly. We heavily rely on our volunteer firefighters in Knights Landing and Robbins when these tragedies occur, and the burden should not fall entirely on their shoulders. As somebody part of the Robbins Fire Department, I have seen firsthand how dangerous this road is.

If a traffic study were possible for this stretch of County Road 102, that would be a crucial step toward bettering an increasingly dangerous situation.
