I would like to submit the following comment for the upcoming Board of Supervisors meeting happening on Tuesday:

Board County Supervisors,

I am writing to you from Knights Landing, the small unincorporated town in Yolo County under District 5. [Community members have been meeting](#) to discuss traffic concerns on County Road 102, and we look forward to the next steps and what else can be done. We urge California Highway Patrol, the Yolo County Sheriff's Department, the Public Works Division, and most importantly, our elected representatives, to hear our pleas for a safer road. Knights Landing is ready to voice additional concerns on the county level for upgraded road safety measures on County Road 102, whether that be advocating further for a 4-way stop at the intersection of Road 17 or speed bumps as Highway 113 turns into our town.

We have seen a change in other intersections along County Road 102, including at the intersection of County Road 27 in between Woodland and Davis, in the creation of a four-way stop. And we are aware of the current project for County Road 98 between Woodland and Davis, the Bike and Safety Improvement Project. We urge the board to please consider a similar approach for the stretch of County Road 102 between Knights Landing and Woodland. Though we are a small town, we matter as well. That road is well used by every driver in our town, and by many other drivers in the area. We deserve to feel safe on our commutes into Woodland, which is the closest city to us and the place where we shop for food and access critical resources.

Too many have died on that road. When will it be enough for action to be taken on the county level? Or at the very least, added to an agenda in one of these meetings, which has not been the case.
