**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO BOARD OF STATE  
AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS (BSCC) PROPOSITION 64  
PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of State and Community Corrections (“BSCC”) is administering the Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Yolo desires to apply for grant funds from the BSCC Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program to support illegal cannabis cultivation enforcement and related public health and safety efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, the BCSS Prop 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program Cohort 4 application period is currently open, with proposals due March 30, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Yolo understands that, if awarded, grant funds shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

1. The Director of Environmental Health, or designee, be authorized on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo to submit the grant proposal for this funding to the Board of State and Community Corrections and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof.
2. If the grant is awarded, the Director of Environmental Health, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the grant agreement with the BSCC, and any amendments thereto, and any other documents necessary to carry out the grant, subject to approval as to form by County Counsel and as to fiscal provisions by the Department of Financial Services, as required by County policy.
3. The County of Yolo agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.
4. Grant funds received under this program shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors.
